- Heros of the Development Profession was the name of the presentation given by Dr. McNay. \$373 billion was given in contributions in 2015, of that 32% were religious, 15% education, and 12% human services. 71% of those contributions came from individuals, while 16% came from foundations, 9% bequests (which are the fastest growing type of contribution), and 5% from corporations. Dr. McNay discussed the types of gifts, which are annual, capital, endowment and planned. She also discussed the qualities of a good grant writer/fundraiser and these are just a few of them; believe in mission, think outside the box, connect the dots, have 3 institutional relationships, research and do homework, prioritize, and be dependable.
